Assam Public Service Commission invites application from Indian Citizens as defined in Articles 5 to 8 of the Constitution of India for the under-mentioned posts under Assam Government in the scale of pay as indicated below and carrying usual allowances as admissible under Rules of the Govt. of Assam.

(A) 1. **Name of Post: Fishery Development Officer under Fishery Department.**

- I. There shall be 30% reservation for women candidates out of existing percentage of reservation of posts earmarked for General/STP/ST(H)/OBC and MOBC where it is applicable subject to fulfillment of other criteria.
- II. There will be 3% reservation for Persons with Disability (PWD) candidates as per provision of relevant Act and Rules.

4. **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION :-**

The Minimum Educational qualification- B.F.Sc Degree from any College/University recognized by the I.C.A.R or D.F.Sc or Master of Science (Fisheries) from C.I.F.E. Mumbai or any other Institute of the I.C.A.R.

5. **SCALE OF PAY :-**

Rs. 30,000/- to 1,10,000/- with Grade Pay Rs. 12,700/- plus other allowances as admissible under Rules.

6. **AGE :-**

21 years to 43 years as on 01/01/2018 as per Govt. OM No. ABP.06/2016/04 dated 03.03.2016. The upper age limit is relaxable as per provision in case of SC/STP/STH candidates. Relaxation for upper age will be considered as per existing rules.

7. Any employee of Fishery Department including Fishery Demonstrator having the requisite qualification of B.F.Sc or equivalent as stated above may apply through proper channel.

4. **Scale of pay :** Pay Band-4, Rs. 30,000-1,10,000/- (Grade Pay of Rs. 12,700/-)

5. **Age:**

Candidates must not be below 23 (twenty three) years and above 43 (forty three) years on 01/01/2018. In case of ST/SC candidates the upper age is further relaxable by another 5(five) years as per Govt. OM.No.ABP. 06/2016/04,dtd.03/03/2016.

6. **Qualification:**

Degree or Diploma equivalent to a Degree of a recognized University in any branch of Medicine.

7. **Experience:**

The candidates should have at least 2 (two) years in a Public Hospital or Factories, Medical Department or alternatively a Diploma in Industrial medicine.

4. **Scale of Pay :** Rs.30,000-1,10,000/- plus Grade pay of Rs.16900/- of PB-4 plus other allowances as admissible under the Rules of Govt. of Assam.

5. **Age:**

Not less than 35 years or more than 45 years as on 01-01-2018. Provided that for candidates belonging to the Assam Economics & Statistics service there shall be no upper age limit.

**6. Educational Qualification:**

(a) Atleast 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Master's Degree in Statistics, Mathematics, Economics from a recognized University or its equivalent.

Or

Degree of a recognized University with Mathematics, Statistics, Economics as subject and a Diploma recognized by Govt. obtained after atleast 2(two) years Post Graduate training in Statistics.

(b) Not less than 10(ten) years experience in Statistical Works/Investigation/Research/ in a Govt. Deptt. or Commercial concern of repute or in conducting or guiding Research in Statistics in a University or Institute of Training & Research as evidenced by published work. Administrative experience for not less than 5 years in a responsible capacity.

4. **Scale of Pay** : (PB-4) Rs. 30,000/- to 1,10,000/- GP-12,700/-

5. **Age:** Minimum 21(twenty one) years and Maximum 43 (forty three) years as on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 as per Govt. OM No.ABP/062016/4, dated 03/03/2016. However, the upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years in case of SC/ST(P) and ST(H) candidates.

#### 6. **Essential Qualification : For Sl. No.1(a),2,3 & 4**

- Bachelor Degree from a University recognized by UGC.
- 3(Three) years diploma in concerned subject with minimum 55% marks from an institute under State/Central Government and approved by AICTE.
- At least 5 years teaching experience in the concerned subject in an organization of institution of repute under AICTE.

#### **For Sl. No.1 (b)**

- M.E or M.Tech in Electronic Telecommunication.
- Knowledge of Audio-visual Media.
- Professional/Teaching experience in this field in recognized Institute/University is preferable.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

- The name of the post applied for should be clearly written in “**bold letters**” in the Envelope containing the application form and it should be addressed to the **Under Secretary, APSC, Jawaharnagar, Khanapara, Guwahati-22.**
- Application form may be obtained by downloading the same from the APSC’s website [www.apsc.nic.in](http://www.apsc.nic.in).
- Application Fees :**

As per Govt. **Notification No. FEG.32/2016/8-A dated Dispur the 28<sup>th</sup> October,2016** the Application Fees for all post under the State Govt. of Assam shown as below:

- For General Candidate : Rs.250/- (Rupees two hundred and fifty) only.**
- For SC/ST/OBC/MOBC : Rs.150/- (Rupees one hundred and fifty) only.**
- Candidates having BPL Certificate : Nil (Candidate having BPL certificate should produce their photocopy of certificate along with the Application Form).**

Fees should be deposited only through Treasury Challan in the Head of Account "**NON TAX REVENUE, OTHER NON TAX REVENUE 0051 PSC, 105 STATE PSC APPLICATION FEE RECEIPT OF APSC**" showing name of post and department. **Original copy of Treasury Challan should be submitted along with the application form.**

- d. The last date of receiving duly filled up application form in the Commission's office is fixed on **19/03/2018** during office hours.
- e. Applications (including applications received through post) received after the last date fixed for receipt shall not be entertained.
- f. Only applications which are signed by the candidates and accompanied by all particulars as called for in the application form prescribed by the Commission only shall be considered and candidates fulfilling all the terms of the advertisement of the respective posts shall be called for a Screening test / Viva-voce interview where necessary as decided by the Commission.
- g. (i) All candidates, whether in Government Service or in Government owned undertaking or other similar organizations/Corporations/boards/ or in private employment may intimate their controlling authority instead of routing it through the same wherever applicable except in the posts in Sl. (A). However, the fact of the intimation may be apprised to the Commission by the candidate.  
(ii) The Commission shall in no way be responsible in the event of any candidate after appointment is not released by the concerned authority to enable him/her to join the new post.
- h. The candidates must clearly state the documents enclosed with the application in relevant section of the application form.

### **HOW TO FILL UP THE FORM**

- a. Applicants must affix 1 (One) copy of recent photograph on the space provided in the application form firmly with good quality glue/adhesive and also should enclose another copy along with the application. The photograph must be signed prominently. The Commission shall not be responsible for detachment/ loss of the photograph.
- b. Since the practice of furnishing attested copies of certificates/mark sheets etc. by competent authority has been discontinued by the Govt., the applicant shall furnish copies of certificate/mark sheet etc. declared by himself/herself as certified to be true copy of the original along with the application.
- c. In case of detection of any false declaration / statement made by any applicant, his/her application will be rejected and will also be penalized as per Rules/Law. Self attested photocopies of Certificate / Mark Sheet from HSLC onwards and also Caste Certificate / Registration Certificate / Experience Certificate (where necessary) should be furnished invariably and should be tagged properly without any chance of getting lost during transit. The Commission will not be responsible for any such loss due to improper tagging.

**d. Incomplete application in terms of the Advertisement will be summarily rejected.**

**No documents will be entertained after the last date of submission of application.**

**WRITTEN TEST / INTERVIEW:**

- i. Commission may short-list the number of candidates either on the basis of their marks obtained in the qualifying academic examination required for the post in terms of advertisement.
