Heard Mr. UK Nair, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. A Chetri, learned counsel for the petitioner in WP(C) 904/2017 and WP(C) 4502/2017, Mr. M Choudhury, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. MK Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner in WP(C) 3931/2017 and WP(C) 7652/2017, Mr. S Saikia, learned counsel for the petitioner in WP(C) 4200/2017 and 7555/2017 and Mr. AK Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner in WP(C) 2278/2017.
