Heard Mr. Sandeep Chamaria, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. T.J Mahanta, learned Sr. counsel assisted by Ms. P. Sarma, learned Standing counsel appearing for the APSC/respondents No. 1 & 2. Also heard Mr. K.K. Bhattacharjee, learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent No.3 and Mr. D.P. Borah, learned Standing counsel appearing for the respondents No. 4 & 5.

On 19.06.2020, this Court had directed that the respondent No. 3 in a sealed cover shall submit the original applications of the petitioner as well as the respondents No. 4 & 5, including their testimonials other certificates submitted by them at the time of filing their applications. This direction has not been complied with by the respondent No.3.

The respondent No.3 is directed to comply with the said direction and submit

the requirements on the next date fixed, failing which the respondent No.3 shall give his personal appearance before this Court to explain as to why the direction passed by this Court has not been complied with.

It is also submitted by Mr. D.P. Borah, learned counsel for the respondents No. 4 & 5 in I.A (C) No. 1244/2021, that this Court had passed the order dated 06.09.2021, observing that there is no restraining order passed by the Court in the connected writ petition or any other proceedings, the respondent authorities are therefore, duty bound to pay the salary to the applicant for the service rendered by him as a Fishery Development Officer. The respondent authorities are directed to comply with the order dated 06.09.2021, passed by this Court within a period of 3(three) weeks.

List this matter again after **3(three) weeks** fixing on **06.12.2021**.
